

Uploading Photo/Images to the Website

Preamble:

Photos/images and links to the Active Elgin website and other website that are uploaded by organizations to promote/advertise their services and facilities must be within the scope of the project and convey the values and goals of Southwestern Public Health.

Policy:

Only photos/images and website links that are relevant to sport, leisure and recreation activities or healthy community design will be included. Photos/images and links will be collected from organizations by Active Elgin or uploaded to Active Elgin by organization via the website.

All organizations photos/images and links to other websites must be in keeping with the mission, goals and scope of Active Elgin. Therefore, Southwestern Public Health reserves the right to refuse and limit images on the website.

Photos/images and links on this website that are obtained and or uploaded from the businesses, organizations and program providers will not be independently verified by Active Elgin or by Southwestern Public Health. The businesses, organizations and program providers are solely responsible for the operation and information (including the right to display such information) provided for posting on this website. Neither Active Elgin nor Southwestern Public Health is responsible for the content or the privacy policies of the websites to which it may link, nor is a link an endorsement of any commercial product or service.

Procedure:

1. An administrator or alternate designated by Southwestern Public Health will review all photos/images received via the website and use discretion in deciding which photos/images to allow. The administrator will also work within the following guidelines:
 - a. The photos/images must be relevant to the sport, recreation or leisure activity of the organization.
 - b. All photos of people being active must include appropriate safety equipment (i.e. a helmet) and sun safety protection is recommended.
 - c. Alcohol use, smoking and vaping cannot be promoted.
 - d. Nutritional aids, supplements and health foods cannot be promoted.
 - e. Gambling activities (such as Bingo) shall not be included.
